

RECOMENDACIONES PARA LA TRAMITACION DE LA VISA DE TRABAJO Y RESIDENCIA EN REINO UNIDO

As of 1 January 2021 there is **no longer free movement of EU nationals to the UK**. As detailed in the UK Research and Development Roadmap published July 2020, the UK has now launched a [Global Talent visa](#), which covers [academic and research staff](#). These visas need an endorsement 'to prove that you are a leader or potential leader' prior to application and cover both where the researcher has a job offer or a funded research grant/fellowship. It can last up to 5 years.

The Home Office will send the visa application to certain 'Endorsing bodies' (such as UKRI, United Kingdom Research and Innovation) depending on the route/type of job offer. Current fees are £608 per person to apply and additional healthcare surcharges (exact rates depend on various circumstances). Other types of research related staff, such as Technicians would likely be covered by the [Skilled Worker visa](#) (which replaces Tier 2 general work visas).

It is understood that any travel and stays in the UK for longer than 90 days in any 180 day period would be subject to visa restrictions.
