

The Rees Rawlings PG Cert ULT Prize 2012

Dr. Maria-de-Gracia Dominguez-Barrera (Honorary Clinical Lecturer at the Academic Unit of Child and Adolescent Psychiatry at Imperial College London) has been awarded the **Rees Rawlings PG Cert ULT (Postgraduate Certificate on University Learning and Teaching) Prize 2012** on the 11th December 2012 at the Rectors Award Ceremony at Imperial College London, South Kensington Campus.

The Rectors Award Ceremony, in the presence of the Rector Sir Keith O’Nions, the Pro Rector for Education Professor Debra Humphris, and the Head of the Graduate School and the School of Professional Development Professor Andrew George, presented College Awards for Excellence in Teaching, Pastoral Care, Research Supervision and Supporting the Student Experience, as well as the Best Portfolio for PGCert ULT and PGDip ULT.

The PG Cert ULT is a postgraduate course organized by the Educational Development Unit, School for Professional Development. It aims to develop professionals currently involved in teaching at Imperial as reflective practitioners by means of excellence in university teaching. The course attracts highly motivated individuals who want to further their understanding and practice of teaching and learning in their personal and disciplinary context. It is a practice-centred flexible course that takes an innovative approach to the study of teaching and learning in the University setting and combines topic modules and participants’ previous experience. Course participants submit a Portfolio as a final summative assessment.

Dr Dominguez-Barrera’s Prize is a recognition of excellence of her final portfolio due to her clear critical engagement with the literature and application of theory to practice which was particularly well realised for work at this level.
